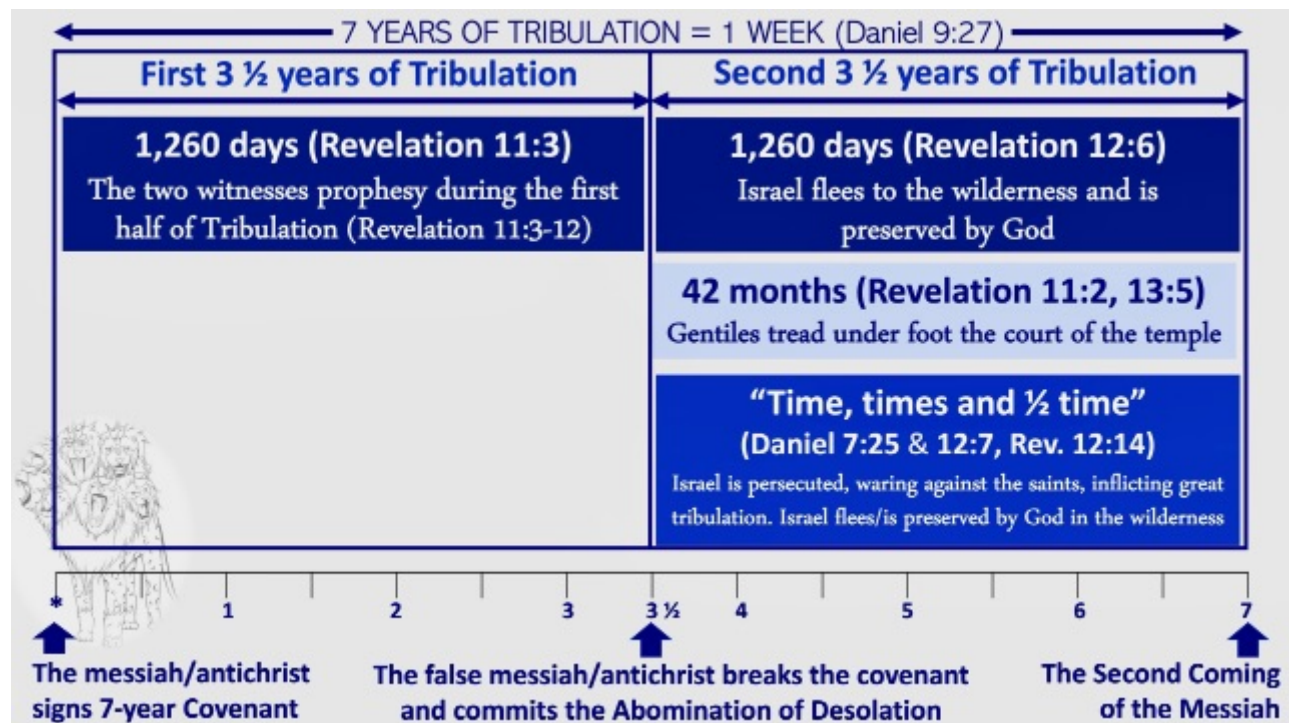

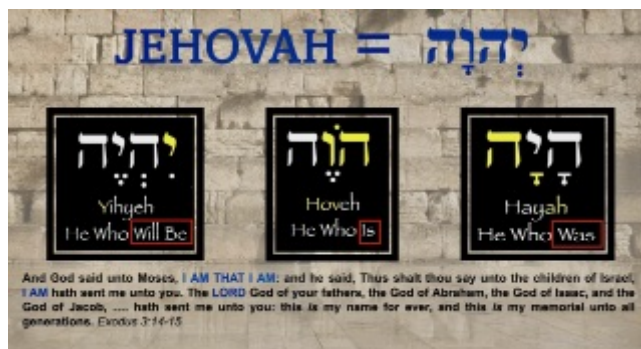

We also learned of the approaching days of Jacob's trouble, and the seven years of Tribulation, which will culminate with the second coming of Jesus the Messiah, to restore His people Israel and to establish the Messianic kingdom. **Seventy sevens are determined upon thy people and upon thy holy city, to finish the transgression, and to make an end of sins, and to make reconciliation for iniquity, and to bring in everlasting righteousness, and to seal up the vision and prophecy, and to anoint the most Holy.** Daniel 9:24. The radio outreach of the Holy Scriptures and Israel has been a blessing, and as the Word is ministered, we pray that the

message will impact the listener. In our communication with listeners, we are able to direct them to certain passages in Scripture, or various resources, which will be helpful to them. Recently,

we received an e-mail from a priest in the Coptic Orthodox Church, who is doing research on the Hebrew Scriptures, the TANACH. He questioned why the Jewish people had not accepted Jesus Christ as the Messiah. After responding to him, we received a thank you note and a request for prayer. Please pray that the Lord will help this person and others with whom we are in touch, that they would be guided by the Holy Spirit and receive the needed help from the Word of God.

We have also posted on our Holy Scriptures and Israel Youtube Channel a new video series on the seven I Am statements of our Lord *Yeshua* / Jesus the Messiah. During His life on earth, He proclaimed that He was Divine and equal with God, saying, **I and my Father are one.** John 10:30. These I Am statements were spoken by the Lord *Yeshua* the Messiah to our people Israel. They struggled, as many others have, to understand this fundamental truth, that the Eternal Son, took union, humanity with His divine nature, and as Man He died for sin. It is He of whom we read in Exodus 3. **And God said unto Moses, I AM THAT I AM: and he said, Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, I AM hath sent me unto you. And God said moreover unto Moses, Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, The LORD God of your fathers, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob, hath sent me unto you: this is my name for ever, and this is my memorial unto all generations.** Exodus 3:14-15.
