As we are working on our newsletter for April, we are on the way back home from the USA, where we enjoyed the blessing of attending the workers conference in Bethesda, Maryland. We are thankful for the hospitality of the local brethren, and with the encouragement we all received as we were occupied with the person of the Lord Jesus. It was good to be under the sound of the Word, and hear how the Lord is using His servants in the field to which they were called. While the people of God are facing many challenges, we were encouraged to continue-on, following after our Lord Jesus the Messiah, who remains the same and changes not. We were compelled to continue on in the various spheres of service, which the Lord has entrusted to us, sharing the message of the gospel, and encouraging the saints of God.

We were also challenged with the fact, that if we are to experience any revival during these last days of the church, every believer is called to develop a greater attitude of prayer, and to have a greater degree of dependence upon the Lord in our lives. We looked at Jesus the Messiah, as the servant of the Lord, who trusted in His faithful God, that changes not. The Hebrew writer

wrote to the early brethren in the first century these words; **Remember them which have the rule over you, who have spoken unto you the word of God: whose faith follow, considering the end of their conversation. Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and today, and forever.** Hebrews 13:7-8. Although things are changing around us, our Lord *Yeshua*, Jesus the Messiah changes not, He remains the same, and we are called to remember this: our God changes not.

These last few days, along with the people of Israel and the Jewish community worldwide, we are pausing to remember the six million Jewish people who were killed during the Holocaust. In Hebrew, the name Holocaust is known as the SHOAH, the genocide of the European Jews during World War II, between 1941 and 1945. Who can imagine that such a thing could happen to our Jewish people or to any people, our hearts by nature are so sinful, that we are capable of doing such things to one another.



The sound of sirens were sounded across all Israel on the 18th of April in order to remind all to pause in remembrance of the six million Jews who were killed in the SHOAH / the Holocaust. Every year as the memorial date arrives, our hearts are heavy with the remembrance of the terrible genocide which took place in recent history, some 80-84 years ago. We thank God that one day this kind of human behaviour will come to an end.

We must be mindful of that which the Word of God teaches us regarding the evil plan of satan, who continuously seeks to do away with God's chosen people Israel, in order to thwart the plan of God. He attempted to prevent the Messiah being born into this world, through His people Israel. Thankfully, satan has not been successful, the Messiah *Yeshua* / Jesus has come, as the Word of God foretold, accomplishing redemption for us all through His substitutionary death, burial, and resurrection. But, dear brothers and sisters this is not the end, satan continues to seek to do away with the Jewish people. Satan knows that in the plan of God, which is recorded in His Word, this same Jesus the Messiah, will come again the second time, in order to reign as the King of Israel, the King of kings and Lord of lords, over the whole world. Let us never forget to pray that the people of Israel will come to faith in the Lord Jesus the Messiah. **For if the casting away of them be the reconciling of the world, what shall the receiving of them be, but life from the dead.** Romans 11:15.

Satan is a defeated foe, God promised that this same Jesus who is still rejected by Israel and the nations of the world today, will come back again, just as Shaul / Paul wrote, quoting Isaiah the prophet saying. **For I would not, brethren, that ye should be ignorant of this mystery, lest ye should be wise in your own conceits; that blindness in part is happened to Israel, until the fulness of the Gentiles be come in. And so all Israel shall be saved: as it is written, There shall come out of Zion the Deliverer, and shall turn away ungodliness from Jacob.** Romans 11:25-26. What a day that will be when Israel will be restored to her Messiah, and the world will be blessed. We read in Philippians 2:10-11; **That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth, And that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.**
