Dear brothers and sisters in Messiah,

Shalom! שלום!

“Then he answered and spake unto me, saying, This is the word of Jehovah unto Zerubbabel, saying, Not by might, nor by power, but by my Spirit, saith Jehovah of hosts.”

We greet you in the precious name of our Lord Yeshua the Messiah, thankful for each of you who uphold us and the outreach ministry to our Jewish people in prayer. As summer draws to its close, we are reminded that the seasons

themselves are the Lord's, and that He **changeth the times and the seasons** (Daniel 2:21), while His Word stands unchanged forever.

On the biblical calendar, the month of Elul began in the middle of August. For generations these weeks have been set apart by our people as a season of returning to the LORD, of searching the heart in preparation for the Days of Awe. Throughout Elul the shofar is sounded in the synagogue, a call to awake and to turn. The prophet Isaiah gives the true voice of this season: **Seek ye the LORD while he may be found, call ye upon him while he is near: let the wicked forsake his way, and the unrighteous man his thoughts: and let him return unto the LORD, and he will have mercy upon him; and to our God, for he will abundantly pardon** (Isaiah 55:6-7).

The Fall Feasts now stand at the door: Rosh Hashanah, the Feast of Trumpets, begins at sundown on Friday, September 11th; Yom Kippur, the Day of Atonement, at sundown on Sunday, September 20th; and Sukkot, the Feast of Tabernacles, at sundown on Friday, September 25th. How we pray that in this season of the trumpet call, many of our people would hear the voice of the One who has already made atonement, and find in Yeshua the Messiah the pardon this season longs for.

THE WORK

The new website has launched.

In our July letter we shared news for which we had long laboured and prayed, and we asked your prayers as we completed the final preparations of our completely renewed website. With full hearts we can now tell you that the Lord has answered. It has been rebuilt from the ground up to be a lasting digital home for Gideon's vast archive of Bible teachings: more than six hundred verse-by-verse messages, kept the way a Bible is kept, book by book from Genesis to Revelation, searchable by book and chapter; the printed booklets, which may be ordered by mail or read at once as PDFs; and the weekly premieres, the podcast, the radio schedule, the recorded interviews, and the newsletters, gathered in one place.

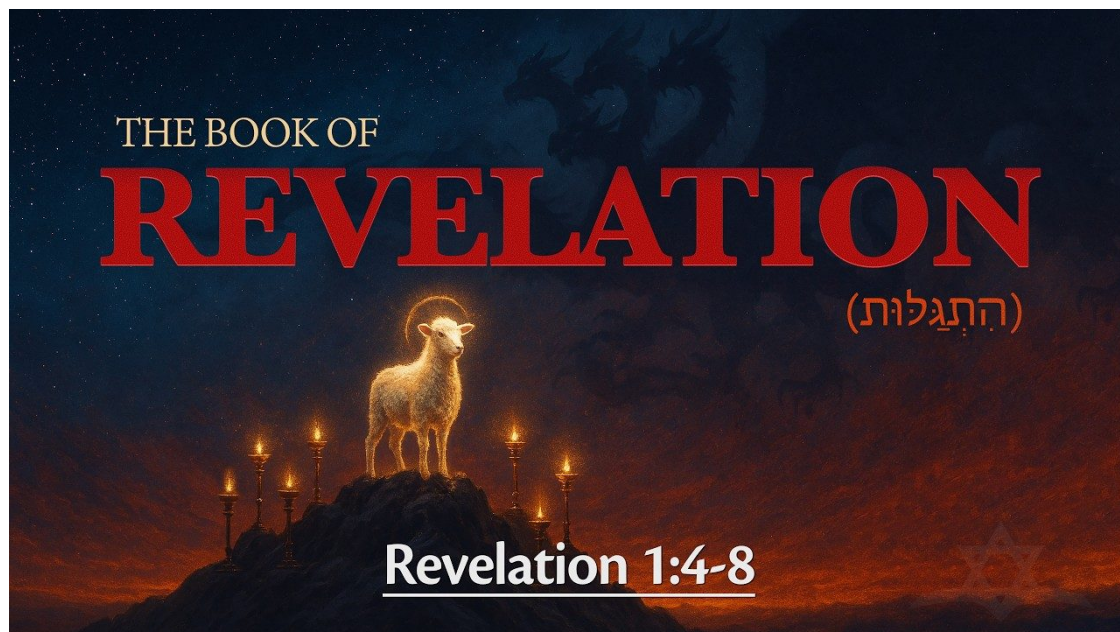

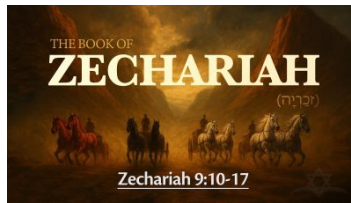
The teaching goes forth, week by week.

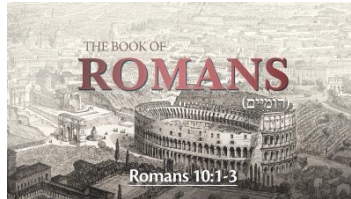
Revelation 1:4-8 • Yeshua the Faithful Witness and Coming King

Verse 9 was fulfilled when Yeshua rode into Jerusalem on a donkey; verse 10 awaits His return, when He will speak shalom to the nations.



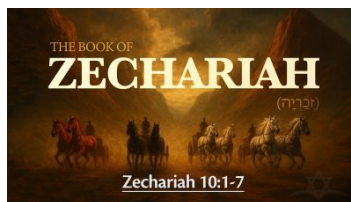
Romans 10:1-3 • My Heart's Desire Is That Israel Might Be Saved
